# f. Lake Agassiz and Northwest Support

The three year \$5000/year grant for each NW and Lake Agassiz to purchase eBooks will end this fiscal year. Kathy recommends that the board make these expenditures permanent budget items along with an extra \$3000 per years for NW to purchase the Tumble Book Library (electronic books for children preK – Grade 3.

Motion to add line items to the NLLN budget of \$5000 each for NW Regional Library System and Lake Agassiz Regional Library System for eBooks and line items for the Viking Library System of \$5000 for delivery and \$600 to provide bookmobile service to the Campbell school.
